Notary page - FEC complaint of Conni Brunni (sworn and subscribed July 16, 2026)

Scan of the notary page from the Florida Elections Commission complaint filed by Conni Brunni concerning Jim DeNiro's residency. The notarization block is transcribed verbatim below; the unaltered scan follows. The Venice Gondolier (July 22, 2026) reported the complaint was submitted by mail on Friday, July 17, 2026 - the sworn date on the primary document is July 16, 2026.

Significance within this record: the sworn date (July 16) precedes by one day the mailing date (July 17) reported by the Venice Gondolier, and falls one day after the July 15 homestead inquiry from cindyjones91745@yahoo.com (FOIA Part 2). The primary notary document controls for the sworn date.

No legal conclusion is drawn. Readers can compare the dates against the documents already published in this timeline.
